STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes, relating to auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty-four of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words
- 3 "their county" in the second line, and inserting
- 4 instead thereof the words 'the state,' so that said
- 5 section, as amended, shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 1. The municipal officers of any town may
- 7 license any suitable inhabitants of the state, by a
- 8 writing under their hands, to be auctioneers for one
- 9 year in any town in said county, and shall record
- 10 every such license in a book kept by them for that
- 11 purpose. Persons so licensed may be exempted from

- 12 any liability to deduct two and one-half per cent.
- 13 from the gross amount of sales as provided in section
- 14 three.
