STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes, relating to auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter thirty-four of the revised 2 statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words 3 “their county.” in the second line, and inserting 4 instead thereof the words ‘the state,’ so that said 5 section, as amended, shall read as follows :

6 *Sect. 1.* The municipal officers of any town may 7 license any suitable inhabitants of the state, by a 8 writing under their hands, to be auctioneers for one 9 year in any town in said county, and shall record 10 every such license in a book kept by them for that 11 purpose. Persons so licensed may be exempted from

12 any liability to deduct two and one-half per cent.

13 from the gross amount of sales as provided in section

14 three.
