STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to correct an error in the last line of the third section of chapter one hundred and fifteen of the revised statutes, relative to the salary of the judge of probate for the county of York.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The last line of the third section of
- 2 chapter one hundred and fifteen of the revised statutes,
- 3 is hereby amended by striking out the word "four"
- 4 and inserting the word "six" so as to make the law
- 5 the same as it was prior to the last revision of the
- 6 statutes.
 - Sect. 2. All payments heretofore made by the
- 2 county treasurer to the judge of probate of the county
- 3 of York, for his salary, are hereby ratified and made

- 4 valid; and this act is to be of the same effect as if
- 5 approved February first, eighteen hundred seventy-
- 6 one, and is to be in force from and after the date of
- 7 its approval.
