STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to repeal the tenth section of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, and reviving chapter forty-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, relating to fines and costs of criminal prosecutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The tenth section of chapter one hundred and sixteen
2 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, and the
3 provisions of chapter forty-one of the public laws of
4 the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, relating to
5 fines and costs of criminal prosecutions, are hereby
6 revived, and are to be in force from and after the ap
7 proval of this act.
