STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT in relation to the redemption of personal property held as security for debt.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That all personal property held as security for debt

- 2 by the agreements and notes, mentioned in section five
- 3 of chapter one hundred and eleven of the revised stat-
- 4 utes, shall be subject to a redemption, as provided for
- 5 in cases of personal property mortgaged by sections
- 6 three, four, five and six of chapter ninety-one of the
- 7 same, and shall be subject to trustee process as pro-
- 8 vided in section fifty of chapter eighty-six of said
- 9 statutes, in relation to property mortgaged; but the
- 10 parties may lawfully stipulate, in said notes, that no
- 11 right of redemption shall exist after breach thereof by
- 12 non-payment.
