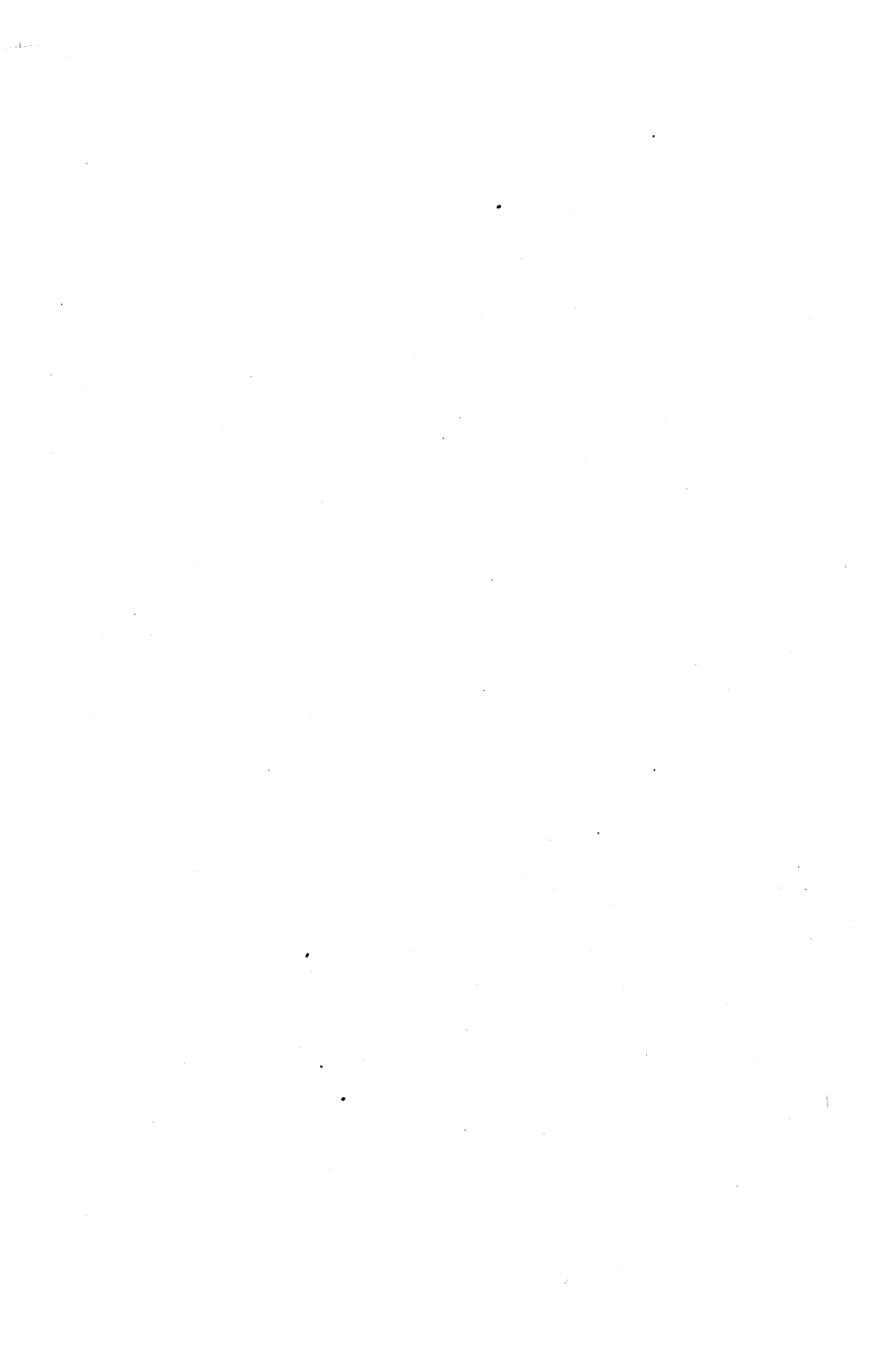

AN ACT relating to the fees for serving subpoenas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The fees for the service of subpoenas in criminal cases shall hereafter be fifty cents, instead of twenty-
