IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to return of the names of plantation officers to the secretary of state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The returns required by section fifty-two of chapter

- 2 three of the revised statutes, to be made by the clerks
- 3 of organized plantations on or before the first day of
- 4 July annually, shall be made on or before the first day
- 5 of August annually, instead of on or before the first
- 6 day of July, as provided in said section fifty-two.
