STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to section sixty of chapter eleven of the school laws, relating to the duties of school agents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sixth—When empowered by the town to employ 2 teachers, before the commencement of a term of school, 3 to give written notice to some member of the superin-4 tending school committee, or to the supervisor, when 5 it is to commence, whether to be taught by a master 6 or mistress, and how long it is expected to continue.
