STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred eighty-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-seven
2 of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 one, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. The organization of any corporation already
2 formed under the provisions of sections eighteen, nine-
3 teen and twenty of chapter forty-eight of the revised
4 statutes, is hereby made legal, notwithstanding any
5 failure to comply with the provisions of section one of
6 the act hereby repealed if otherwise organized accord-
7 ing to law.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
