AN ACT to repeal sections five, six, seven and eight of  
chapter thirty of the revised statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Sections five, six, seven and eight of  
2 chapter thirty of the revised statutes, relating to  
3 bounty on wolves and bears, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
