
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to an act establishing the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts, approved February twenty-fifth, eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Females, who possess the suitable quali-2 fications for admission to the several classes, may be 3 admitted as students in the college, subject to the 4 requirements of labor and study, which may be deter-5 mined by the faculty of instruction and by the trustees 6 of the college.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval 2 by the governor.
