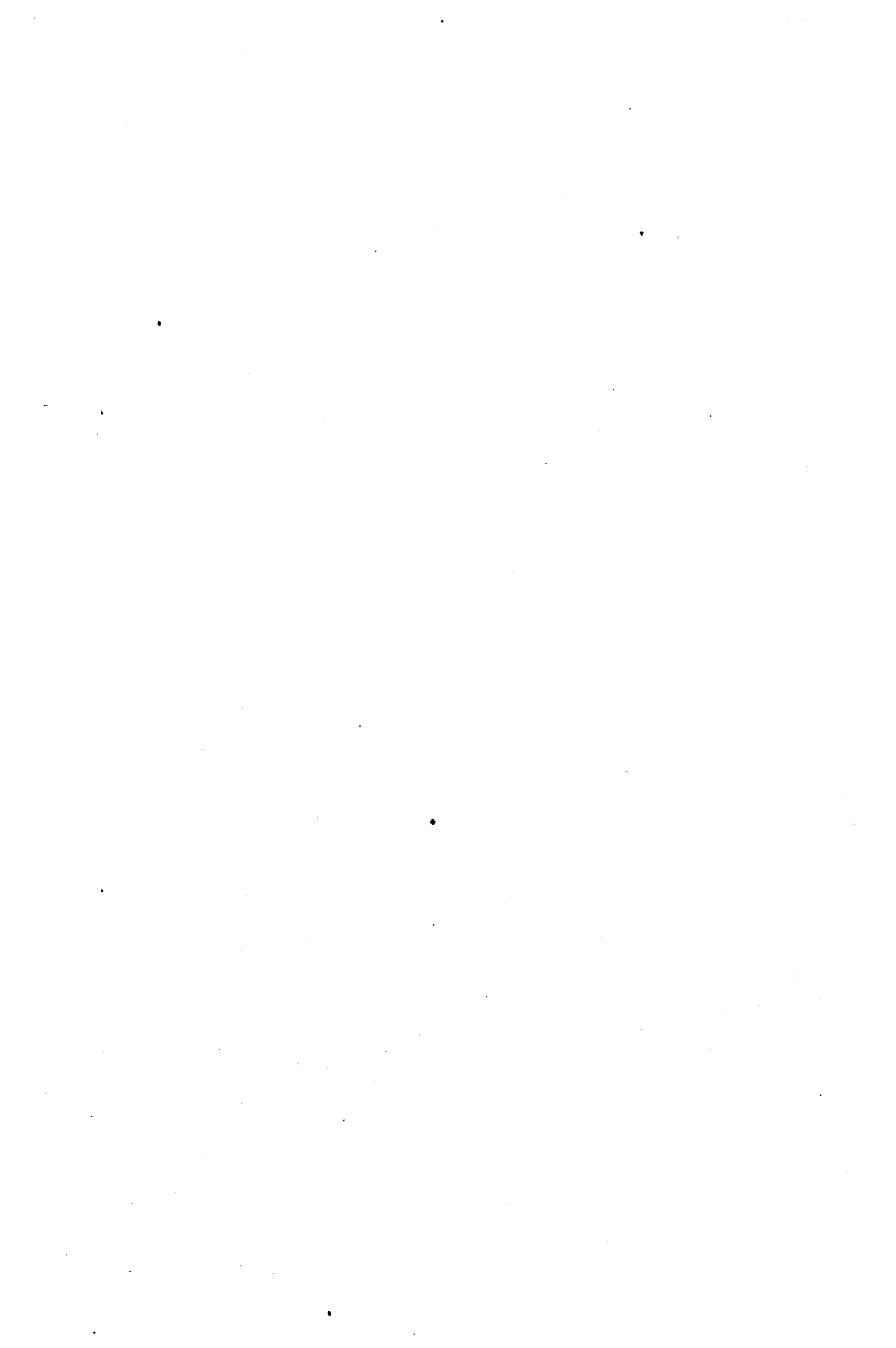
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to an act establishing the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts, approved February twenty-fifth, eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Females, who possess the suitable qualifications for admission to the several classes, may be admitted as students in the college, subject to the requirements of labor and study, which may be determined by the faculty of instruction and by the trustees of the college.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the governor.
