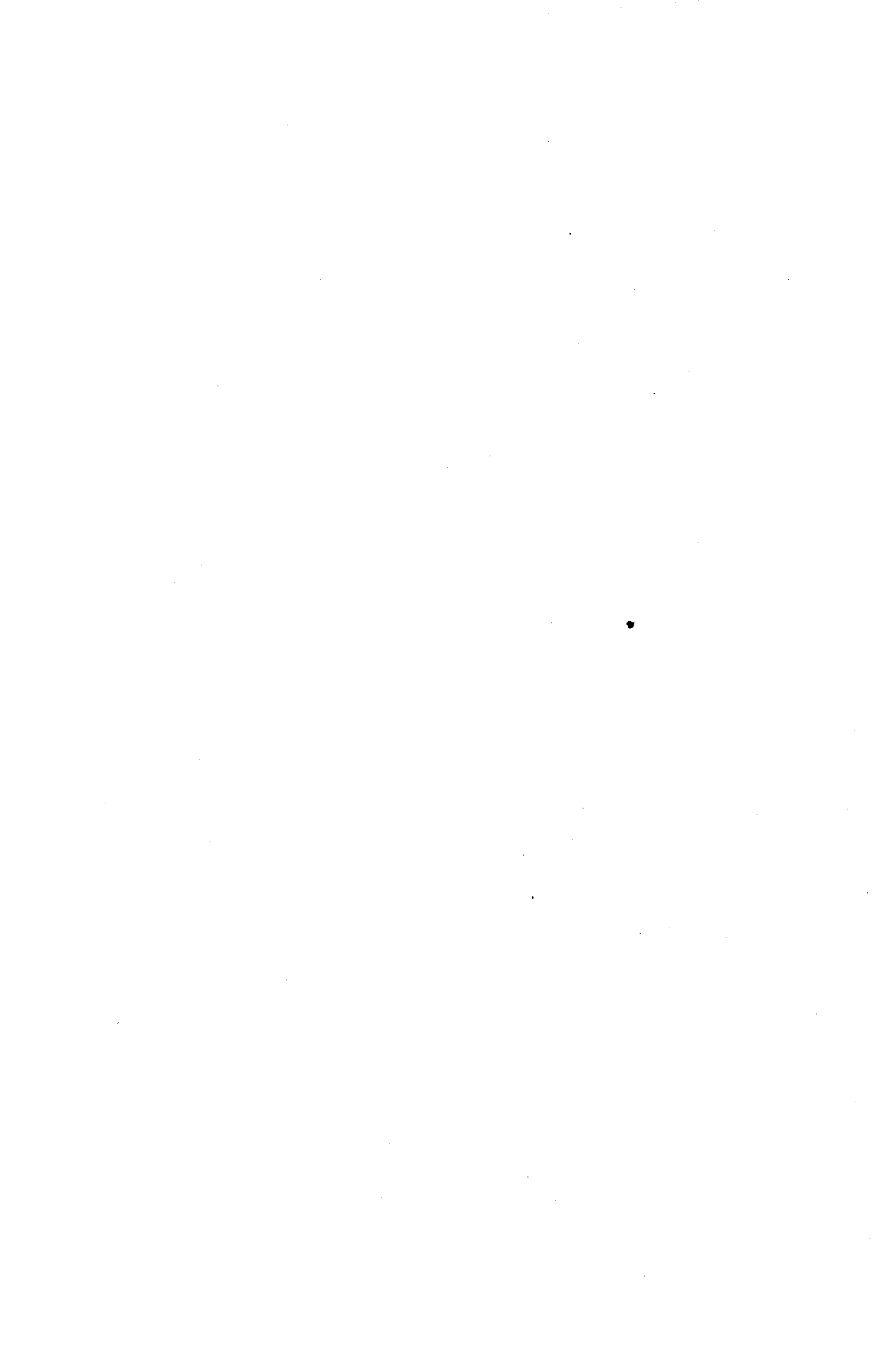
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes, relating to executors and administrators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Executors or administrators residing out of the state,
2 at the time of giving notice of their appointment, shall
3 appoint an agent or attorney in the state, and insert
4 his name and address in such notice. Demand or ser-
5 vice made on said agent or attorney, shall bind the
6 principals and the estate in their care as if made on
7 themselves.
