## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT in relation to normal schools and normal departments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the principals of 2 the normal schools, and of all other schools in which 3 normal departments are supported wholly or in part by 4 the state, to keep a school register containing the 5 names of all students entering such schools or depart-6 ments, the date of entering and leaving, their ages, 7 number of days' attendance, the length of the school 8 term, list of text-books used, and all other information 9 required, in blanks to be furnished from the office of 10 the state superintendent of common schools. The reg-11 ister and blanks thus furnished and kept shall be re-12 turned annually to the state superintendent of common 13 schools on or prior to the first of December, and the14 same shall appear in his annual school report for the15 use and benefit of the legislature.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
