IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to injuries by reason of defective highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No person shall recover of any city or town in this

- 2 state, damage for injury done to person or property,
- 3 which damage is claimed to have been done in conse-
- 4 quence of any defect or want of repair, or sufficient
- 5 railing in any highway, townway, causeway or bridge;
- 6 provided, the said damage be done to, or claimed by,
- 7 any person who was, at the time said damage was
- 8 done, a resident of any country where damage done
- 9 under similar circumstances is not recoverable by the
- 10 laws of said country.
