IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to institute harbor masters in towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. That the selectmen of towns, where
- 2 they deem it expedient, may hereafter annually ap-
- 3 point a suitable person for harbor master, who shall
- 4 be subject to all the duties and liabilities of said officer
- 5 in cities, fix and establish the compensation to be re-
- 6 ceived by him, and to remove from office for just and
- 7 reasonable cause, by them declared in writing, after
- 8 due notice to such officer and hearing thereon, if re-
- 9 quested, and appoint another in his stead.
 - Sect. 2. In localities where two or more towns or
- 2 cities, or town and city, are situated on the same gen-

- 3 eral harbor, the larger town or city shall have the
- 4 appointing power as above.
