STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to institute harbor masters in towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. That the selectmen of towns, where
2 they deem it expedient, may hereafter annually ap-
3 point a suitable person for harbor master, who shall
4 be subject to all the duties and liabilities of said officer
5 in cities, fix and establish the compensation to be re-
6 ceived by him, and to remove from office for just and
7 reasonable cause, by them declared in writing, after
8 due notice to such officer and hearing thereon, if re-
9 quested, and appoint another in his stead.

SECT. 2. In localities where two or more towns or
2 cities, or town and city, are situated on the same gen-

3 eral harbor, the larger town or city shall have the
4 appointing power as above.
