STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to an act entitled an act additional
for the assessment and collection of taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The provisions of an act entitled an act
2 additional for the assessment and collection of taxes,
3 approved February twenty-seven, eighteen hundred
4 seventy-one, chapter two hundred and thirty, shall
5 not apply to hides owned by persons residing out of
6 the state, nor to the leather the product of such hides,
7 when it appears that the hides were sent into the state
8 for the purpose of being tanned, and to be carried out
9 of the state when tanned.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
