STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to the industrial statistics of Maine.

Resolved, That under the direction of the governor
2 and council, a compendium of the report of the recent
3 United States census be prepared and printed; the
4 same to exhibit, in a condensed form, the statistics of
5 industry for each city and town in the state of Maine.
6 It shall be the duty of the clerk employed in the com-
7 pilation of said statistics, to secure, so far as practica-
8 ble by circulars and correspondence, facts additional
9 to and in modification of the statistics of said census,
10 to the end that the said compendium may contain a
11 true industrial record of the state for the current year.
12 It shall be the duty of the aldermen of each city, and
13 selectmen of each town in the state, to furnish in re-
14 sponse to the enquiries of said clerk, facts as above
15 specified, on or before the first day of October, in the
16 current year. To meet the necessary expenditures of

17 said compilation, the governor is hereby authorized to
18 draw his warrant upon the treasury for the required
19 amount, and from any moneys not otherwise appro-
20 priated.
