## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT defining the duties of the superintendent and steward of the insane hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The superintendent and steward of the
- 2 insane hospital shall be appointed by the governor and
- 3 council, on recommendation of the trustees, and shall
- 4 hold their office for the term of four years, unless
- 5 sooner removed by the governor and council.
  - Sect. 2. The duties of the superintendent shall be
- 2 and are hereby modified so that they shall apply to
- 3 the medical and sanitary departments only.
  - SECT. 3. The acts and doings of the steward con-
- 2 nected with this institution shall be subject to the ad-
- 3 vice of the trustees and approval of the governor and

- 4 council. He shall be treasurer; give bond to the 5 governor and council, in such amount and with such 6 sureties as they deem sufficient, for the safe keeping 7 and proper disbursement of the funds of the institu-8 tion; make all necessary purchases of supplies and 9 provisions; hire attendants and all other laborers; 10 have the general management of the farm and grounds, 11 including the purchase and sale of stock and other 12 necessary business connected therewith; have a care-13 ful oversight of the patients when employed thereon; 14 annually make a detailed report to the governor and 15 council of his receipts and expenditures, and of the 16 financial affairs of the institution; and repair, erect,
  - SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with 2 this act are hereby repealed.

17 and finish all buildings belonging to the insane hospi-

18 tal without commission.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
