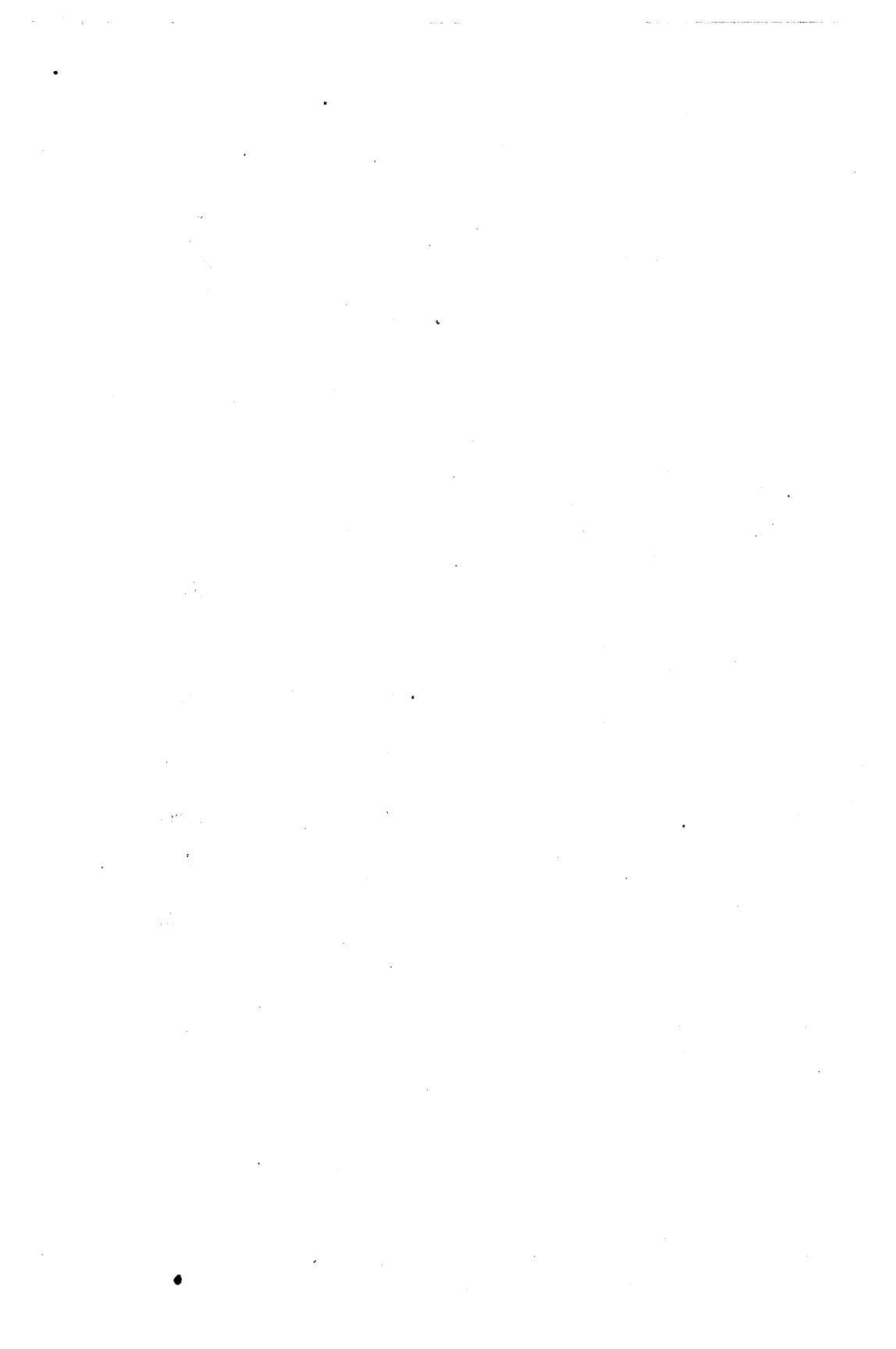
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, relating to town liquor agents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

If any agent appointed under the provisions of section twenty-six of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes to sell intoxicating liquors, shall be convicted of violating any of the provisions of said chapter, he shall forever thereafter be disqualified for holding such office.
