STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter one hundred thirty-two of the revised statutes, relating to the administration of oaths.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and
2 thirty-two of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the words " police courts " in the first
4 line of said section, the words ' justices of the peace,'
5 so that the first clause of said section as amended,
6 shall read as follows :

7 " Sect. 2. Judges of municipal and police courts,
8 justices of the peace and trial justices, may administer
9 all oaths required by law, unless another officer is
10 specially required to do it."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
