AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembleu, as follows:

- Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts
- 2 and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment
- 3 of money from the treasury, and also to provide for
- 4 the necessary expenditures of government for the cur-
- 5 rent fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appro-
- 6 priated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the
- 7 governor with the advice and consent of the council, is
- 8 hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of
- 9 January next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury
- 10 for the same.
