STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-nine of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-nine, concerning the militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The volunteer company known as the
2 Androscoggin Light Artillery, is hereby made subject
3 to all the duties and granted all the privileges pro-
4 vided for volunteer companies of militia by chapter
5 twenty-nine of the laws of eighteen hundred sixty-
6 nine.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
