## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to the change of names of persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whenever any person in this state
- 2 desires to change his or her name, such person may
- 3 petition therefor to the judge of probate of the county
- 4 in which he resides; and such judge of probate is
- 5 hereby authorized and empowered to change the name
- 6 of such person, and shall make and preserve a record
- 7 thereof.
  - SECT. 2. Whenever the judge of probate before
- 2 granting any such petition, deems it expedient that
- 3 notice thereof be given, such notice shall be given
- 4 as the judge may order.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
