STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty, section five of the revised statutes in relation to bounty on wild animals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section five of chapter thirty of the revised statutes, 2 is hereby amended, so that the section as amended will 3 read as follows :

4 *Sect. 5.* A bounty of five dollars for every wolf and 5 bear, two dollars for every wild cat and loupervier 6 and fifty cents on every fox.
