STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifteen of the revised statutes, relating to compensation of members of the government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and fifteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the sixth section thereof, and inserting in place thereof the following :

Sect. 6. Each member of the council shall be paid three dollars for every day's attendance, and two dollars for every ten miles' travel each way from his place of abode at each session. Each member of the senate and house of representatives shall be paid a salary of three hundred dollars for the regular annual session

11 of the legislature, and three dollars for each day's
12 attendance at any extra session called by the gov-
13 ernor, and two dollars for every ten miles' travel each
14 way from his place of abode once in each session. He
15 is entitled to mileage on the first day of the session,
16 and one hundred dollars of his salary on the first day
17 of each month thereafter during the session, and the
18 balance at the end thereof; but five dollars shall be
19 deducted from the pay of every member for each day
20 he is absent from his duties, without being excused
21 by the house to which he belongs. The secretary of
22 the senate and clerk of the house of representatives
23 shall be paid three hundred dollars each, and their
24 assistants two hundred and seventy-five dollars each,
25 for each regular session; and for each extra session,
26 said secretary and clerk shall be paid four dollars and
27 their assistants three dollars each for every day of
28 their employment. The president of the senate and
29 speaker of the house of representatives shall each be
30 paid a salary of five hundred dollars for each regular
31 session, and five dollars for every day's attendance at
32 any such extra session, with the same mileage as other
33 members, and subject to the same deduction in case
34 of absence. Any member acting as president *pro tem.*
35 of the senate or speaker *pro tem.* of the house, shall
36 receive three dollars per day extra therefor. The

37 treasurer of state shall make pay rolls and payments
38 according to these provisions.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after the sixth day of January next.
