STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section one, chapter two hundred and twenty-three of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, relating to fares on railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The provisions of section one, chapter
- 2 two hundred and twenty-three of the public laws of
- 3 eighteen hundred and seventy-one, shall not apply to
- 4 excursion or return tickets sold for a less price than
- 5 the regular fare.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
