STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter thirty of the revised statutes, relating to moose, deer and caribou.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter thirty of the
- 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in
- 3 the fourth line of said section, the word "February,"
- 4 and inserting instead thereof the word 'January'; also
- 5 by striking out the word "so" in the seventh line,
- 6 and all after the word "caribou" in the same line of
- 7 said section, so that said section shall read as follows:
- 8 Sect. 9. No person shall hunt or kill with dogs any
- 9 moose, deer or caribou on any lands in this state un-
- 10 der a penalty of forty dollars for every such moose,
- 11 deer or caribou so killed; and no person shall, between

- 12 the first day of January and the first day of October,
- 13 in any manner hunt or kill any moose, deer or caribou,
- 14 under the same penalties as above provided. Any
- 15 person may lawfully shoot or otherwise kill any dog
- 16 found hunting moose, deer or caribou.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
