STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-seven of chapter eleven of the revised statutes, relating to normal schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section eighty-seven of chapter eleven
- 2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sect. 87. The normal schools established by the
- 5 state shall be under the direction of a board of seven
- 6 trustees, five of whom shall be appointed by the gov-
- 7 ernor, by and with the advice and consent of the council,
- 8 for a term of not more than three years under one
- 9 appointment; and the governor and superintendent of
- 10 common schools shall, by virtue of their office, be mem-
- 11 bers of the board. The five trustees appointed by the

12 governor shall each be allowed ten cents a mile for 13 actual travel each way, and two dollars a day for their 14 services when employed. They shall have charge of 15 the general interests of the state normal schools; shall 16 see that the affairs of the same are conducted as 17 required by law and by such by-laws as the board 18 may adopt; employ teachers and lecturers for the 19 same; and annually on the first day of December, lay 20 before the governor and council, for the information of 21 the legislature, a financial statement, furnishing an 22 accurate detailed account of the receipts and expendi-23 tures for the school year preceding. The governor 24 and council may draw warrants on the treasurer of 25 state in favor of the trustees, from time to time, as 26 they think proper, for the money appropriated by the 27 legislature for the state normal schools.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
