## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to chapter sixty-six of the revised statutes, relating to insolvent estates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. When commissioners appointed under

- 2 the provisions of section fifty-one of chapter sixty-
- 3 four of the revised statutes, have reported on any
- 4 claims submitted to them, and their report has been
- 5 accepted and no appeal taken, it shall be final, not-
- 6 withstanding the estate afterwards proves to be insol-
- 7 vent, and commissioners of insolvency are appointed.
- 8 The amount awarded by the first commissioners shall
- 9 be entered by the judge of probate on the list of debts
- 10 entitled to dividends.

SECT. 2. Commissioners of insolvency who neglect

- 2 to render their report to the judge of probate for three
- 3 months after the expiration of the time allowed them
- 4 by the judge for receiving claims, shall forfeit all right
- 5 to compensation for their services, and may be cited
- 6 by the judge to show cause for their negligence.
- SECT. 3. Chapter forty-seven of the public laws of 2 eighteen hundred and seventy-two, is hereby repealed.
