STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixteen, section eight of the revised statutes, relative to the service of venires.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Chapter one hundred and sixteen, section eight of
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 the words "one dollar and fifty cents," in the second
4 line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the
5 words "the same as is allowed to sheriffs and con-
6 stables for the service, travel and return of writs and
7 precepts," so that said section as amended shall read
8 as follows :

9 *Sect. 8.* The fees of constables for the service,
10 travel, and return of each venire, shall be the same as

11 is allowed to sheriffs and constables for the service,
12 travel and return of writs and precepts, to be paid out
13 of the county treasury ; and for services which may
14 be performed either by a deputy sheriff or a constable,
15 the constable shall be allowed the same fees as a
16 deputy sheriff unless otherwise provided by law.
