STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-seven of the public acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Chapter twenty-seven, section one of the public laws 2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, by striking out 3 in the fifth line " by attachment in courts of competent 4 jurisdiction," so that said section, as amended, shall 5 read as follows :

6 *Sect. 1.* Any person who pastures, feeds or shelter 7 animals by virtue of a contract with, or by consent of 8 the owner, shall have a lien thereon for the amount 9 due for such pasturing, feeding or sheltering, to secure 10 payment thereof with costs, to be enforced in the same 11 manner as liens on goods and personal baggage by inn- 12 holders or keepers of boarding-houses.
