STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-seven of the public acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Chapter twenty-seven, section one of the public laws
 - 2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, by striking out
 - 3 in the fifth line "by attachment in courts of competent
 - 4 jurisdiction," so that said section, as amended, shall
 - 5 read as follows:
 - 6 Sect. 1. Any person who pastures, feeds or shelter
 - 7 animals by virtue of a contract with, or by consent of
 - 8 the owner, shall have a lien thereon for the amount
 - 9 due for such pasturing, feeding or sheltering, to secure
- 10 payment thereof with costs, to be enforced in the same
- 11 manner as liens on goods and personal baggage by inn-
- 12 holders or keepers of boarding-houses.
