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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE providing for a geological survey of the State.

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*Resolved,* That the governor and council are hereby  
2 authorized to appoint three commissioners, who shall  
3 have authority to institute a thorough and systematic  
4 geological survey of the state, and to employ experi-  
5 enced and competent engineers and geologists to con-  
6 duct the same and report thereon to the legislature.

*Resolved,* That the governor and council shall allow  
2 such compensation for travelling and other proper  
3 expenses of said commissioners, not exceeding three  
4 hundred dollars (\$300,) as may be just and reason-  
5 able; and the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)  
6 is hereby appropriated for the payment of the neces-  
7 sary expenses of such survey; and the governor is  
8 hereby authorized to draw his warrants upon the treas-  
9 ury for such sums, not exceeding ten thousand three

10 hundred dollars (\$10,300), as may be required from  
11 time to time by said commissioners for conducting such  
12 survey.
