RESOLVE in favor of the Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of fifty

- 2 thousand dollars to commence the erection of a new
- 3 hospital building north of the engine house and laun-
- 4 dry, and equal distance therefrom, and on a line with
- 5 the old hospital; all plans and specifications of said
- 6 hospital shall be presented to the governor and council
- 7 for approval before commencing the erection of the
- 8 same, all expenses incurred and work done shall be
- 9 under the supervision of the trustees, and all bills
- 10 shall be audited by the governor and council.

AMENDMENT "A," OFFERED BY MR. VINTON.

WHEREAS, The Insane Hospital is now full, and has 2 from time to time been enlarged until no further en-3 largement thereof is feasible, and hence the state is 4 now called upon to enter upon the work of building 5 another Insane Hospital, therefore Resolved, That the governor, with the advice of the 7 council, appoint three commissioners, whose duty it 8 shall be to solicit proposals from cities, towns or indi-9 viduals, as an inducement to the location of said hos-10 pital, shall employ a competent architect to make a 11 plan of said hospital, and an estimate of the cost of 12 the same, shall consider the best method for the state 13 to adopt in its construction, and any other matter 14 legitimately connected therewith, and submit a report 15 upon the whole matter to the next legislature during 16 the first week of its session. The necessary expenses 17 and disbursments of this commission shall be rendered 18 to the governor and council, to be by them audited 19 and allowed.
