
AN ACT to prevent injury to railroad fences or property.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Any person who shall take down or  
2 intentionally injure any railroad fence which has been  
3 erected to protect the line of any railroad in this state,  
4 or shall turn any horse, cattle or other animals upon  
5 or within the enclosures of said railroads, shall upon  
6 complaint and conviction thereof before any court of  
7 competent jurisdiction, be fined not less than ten nor  
8 more than one hundred dollars, to be paid into the  
9 treasury of the county wherein the offence was com-  
10 mitted, or imprisoned not less than ten days or more  
11 than six months in the jail of said county, at the  
12 discretion of said court.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
