STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes, relating to trustee process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section eight of chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by striking out of said section the words "except counties, towns, school districts and parishes," and by adding after the word "agent," in the fifth line, the words 'or such other person as upon whom legal service of the writ may be made,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

9 *Sect. 8.* All corporations may be summoned as
10 trustees, and the writs served on them as other writs
11 on such corporations ; and they may answer by attor-

12 ney or agent, and make disclosures, which shall be
13 signed and sworn to by such attorney or agent, or
14 such other person as upon whom legal service of the
15 writ may be made ; and the same proceedings shall
16 thereupon be had throughout, except necessary changes
17 in form, as in other cases of foreign attachment.
