STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT respecting free ticket passengers on railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Persons traveling in the cars on any railroad in this

- 2 state, upon a free ticket or free pass, shall have the
- 3 same, and no greater or less right, to recover damages
- 4 for any injury he may sustain while so traveling, than
- 5 the president or a director of the road upon which the
- 6 accident happened would have for an injury under like
- 7 circumstances; and such passenger and those claim-
- 8 ing under him shall stand in all respects in the same
- 9 relation to the railroad company as one of its directors,
- 10 as to such right.
