IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT providing for the trial of issues of fact by a
jury in equity cases.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The supreme judicial court shall frame issues of fact
2 to be tried by a jury in equity cases when requested
3 by a party, and direct the same to be tried in the
4 county where such cause is pending, at the bar of
5 said court.
