STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT in relation to attachments in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

When the plaintiff in an action dies before the expi-

- 2 ration of thirty days from the rendition of judgment
- 3 in his favor, execution may issue as is now provided,
- 4 and all attachments then in force shall continue ninety
- 5 days after the next term of the court in that county;
- 6 and if the defendant was arrested on mesne process,
- 7 and gave bond to disclose after judgment, he may do
- 8 so after said next term without breach of his bond.
