STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-three of chapter
seventy-seven of the revised statutes, relating to inter-
est on reports of referees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section twenty-three of chapter seventy-seven of the
2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the words, "or acceptance," and inserting instead
4 thereof, the words 'such verdicts, or making such
5 reports,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
6 as follows :

7 *Sect. 23.* Interest is to be allowed on verdicts and
8 amounts, reported by referees to be due, from the
9 time of finding such verdicts or making such reports,
10 to the time of judgments.
