STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relative to the claims of settlers upon proprietors' lands in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the governor by and with the advice 2 and consent of his council, be and he is hereby author-3 ized and directed to appoint a commissioner, whose 4 duties it shall be to inquire what lands in the planta-5 tions of Letter K and Eagle Lake, in township 6 number seventeen, range six, and in the towns of 7 Madawaska and Frenchville, claimed by or belonging 8 to proprietors, are and have been for the period of at 9 least ten years in the possession or occupation of set-10 tlers; and also to inquire what settlers upon treaty 11 lots have not been quieted in their possessions; and 12 also to ascertain upon what terms such of the lands 13 referred to belonging to proprietors, may be pur-14 chased, which facts together with a list of those 15 coming within the rule above prescribed with the

16 extent of their possessions, with such other suggestions 17 as he may think proper to make, and the expenses of 18 said commissioner shall not exceed the sum of three 19 hundred dollars to be audited and allowed by the 20 governor and council; and the governor is authorized 21 to draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for such 22 amount as shall be allowed.
