## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to chapter fifty-one of the revised statutes, relating to railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any person turning horses, cattle or other animals

- 2 upon the premises of any railroad, or knowingly suffer-
- 3 ing the same to be turned into or upon said premises,
- 4 or knowing the same to be and remain in or upon
- 5 such premises, enclosed by fences as the law pre-
- 6 scribes, shall forfeit for each offence not less than
- 7 twenty nor more than one hundred dollars, to be
- 8 recovered by indictment.
