STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eleven, section fifty-nine of the revised statutes, relating to the pay of school committees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Chapter eleven, section fifty-nine of the revised statutes are hereby amended by striking out after the word "law" and before the word 'and' in the last line, the following, viz., 'one dollar and fifty cents a day and all necessary travelling expenses,' and insert the following, 'three dollars a day including travelling expenses,' so that the section as amended shall read :

Sect. 59. Superintending school committees and supervisors shall be paid for their services on satisfy-

11 ing the municipal officers that they have made the
12 returns to the superintendent of common schools re-
13 quired by law, three dollars a day including travelling
14 expenses, and no more unless ordered by the town.
