STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for a revision of treaties with the Penobscot
tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That the governor, with advice of council,
2 be authorized and required to appoint a commissioner,
3 or commissioners not exceeding two, on the part of
4 the state, and invite the Penobscot tribe of Indians to
5 appoint a similar commission on their part, to revise
6 existing treaties between the State of Maine and said
7 Penobscot tribe, or negotiate a new treaty, whereby
8 said tribe may, in some measure, be raised from their
9 dependent condition, and ultimately become citizens
10 of the state.
