STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to continue in force chapter five, public laws eighteen hundred seventy-two, "an act authorizing pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter five, public 2 laws eighteen hundred seventy-two, are hereby con-3 tinued in force for one year from the thirty-first day 4 of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-.5 two.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
