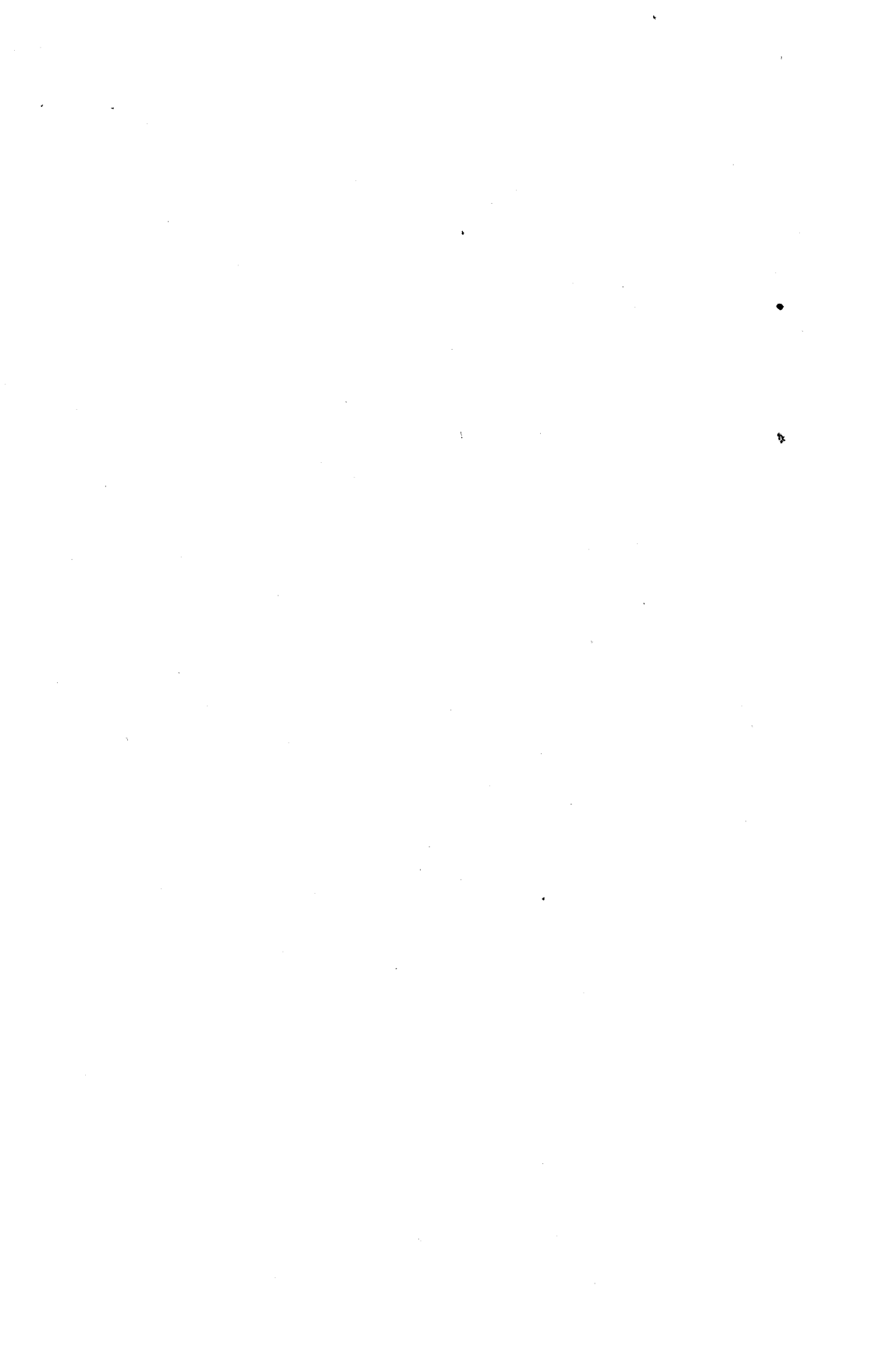
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to attachments of real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Attachments of real estate hereafter
2 made, shall take effect from the time of the reception
3 of the certificate thereof at the office of the register of
4 deeds for record; and so much of section fifty-six,
5 chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes, as is re-
6 pugnant to this act, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
