STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

AN ACT to provide for an enrollment of the militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the assessors of

- 2 cities, towns and plantations of the state to prepare
- 3 lists of all persons who may be living within their
- 4 respective limits and liable to enrollment; giving the
- 5 name, age and occupation of each of such persons, and
- 6 all facts which may determine his exemption from
- 7 military duty, and place a certified copy of such lists
- 8 in the hands of the clerk of their respective cities,
- 9 towns or plantations, on or before the first day of June
- 10 next; and the said clerks shall return copies of such
- 11 lists to the adjutant general at Augusta, on or before
- 12 the fifteenth day of June next.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
