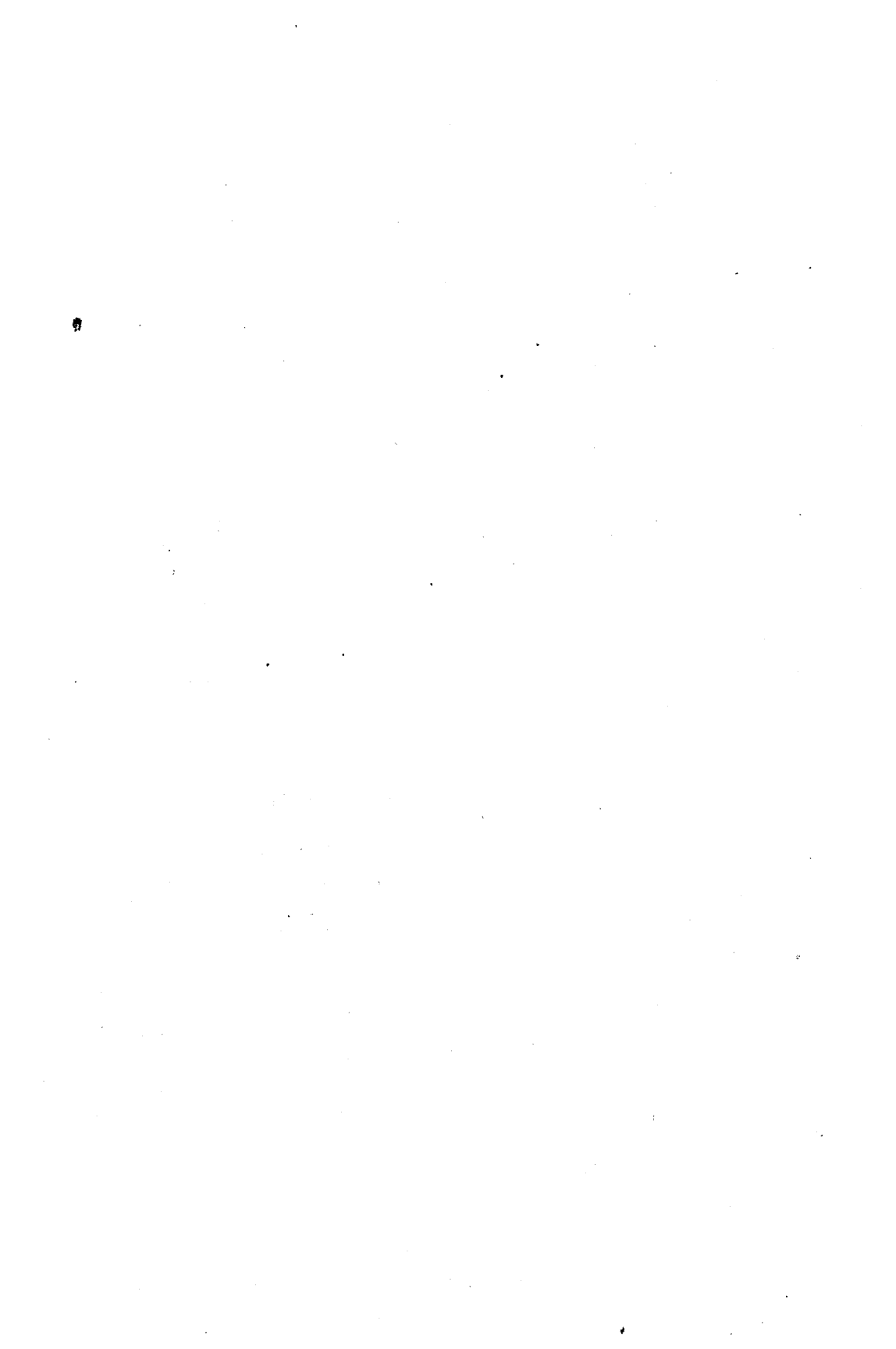

AN ACT to provide for the proper expenditure by towns  
of school money received from the state.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

When the governor and council have reason to believe  
2 that any town has neglected to raise and expend the  
3 school money required by law, or to faithfully expend  
4 the school money received from the state, it shall be  
5 their duty to direct the state treasurer to withhold  
6 further payments to such town from the state treasury  
7 on account of the state school fund and mill tax, until  
8 such town shall satisfy them that it has expended the  
9 full amount required by law for common school  
10 purposes.
